## Mediterranean Initiative III

Building on the success of the Mediterranean Initiative I and II, the Mediterranean Initiative III under the Horizon Europe Work Programme 2026-2027 is intended to continue to support the implementation of the joint regional priorities:



### HEALTH

- Vaccine development
- Antiviral therapeutics
- Monoclonal antibodies



### CLIMATE CHANGE

- Biodiversity
- Plant health



### RENEWABLE ENERGY

- RES-based electricity grids

The **Horizon Europe Work Programme 2026-27 supports this initiative by focusing on 18 topics, with approximately €420 million** allocated to Calls for Proposals promoting R&I cooperation with the Mediterranean region.

This Initiative is part of a broader effort to strengthen the partnership between the EU and Southern Mediterranean countries, focusing on consolidates EU instruments and financial resources within a coherent governance architecture to advance shared priorities, including **innovation, competitiveness, sustainable development, digital transformation, climate resilience, and migration management.**

## Enhancing EU-Southern Mediterranean partnership

The Mediterranean Initiatives are a direct outcome of the first- ever **Union for the Mediterranean (UfM) Ministerial Declaration on R&I, adopted in June 2022.**

The initiatives enhanced EU-Mediterranean research collaboration through 52 topics and a potential investment of around 500 million euro! They focused on key priorities — Health, Climate Change, and Renewable Energy — and their corresponding roadmaps.

In the Mediterranean Initiative I only a total of 18 funded projects involve at least one Mediterranean country. Approximately €245 out of €320 of the EU contribution is allocated to these projects.

Thanks to the success of its predecessor, the European Commission launched [Mediterranean Initiative II](#). The Horizon Europe Work Programme 2025 underpins this initiative through 12 dedicated topics, allocating approximately €165 million to calls for proposals that foster research and innovation cooperation with the Mediterranean region.

## Main actions involving the Mediterranean Region

[The Pact for the Mediterranean](#), “One Sea, One Pact, One Future,” constitutes the EU’s new flagship framework for deepening cooperation with partners across the Southern Mediterranean. In the field of research and innovation (R&I), the Pact aims at:

- establishing **Mediterranean R&I hubs**, support for the **scaling-up of innovative solutions**.
- the creation of an **Euro-Mediterranean Science Diplomacy Centre**,
- the integration of a research pillar within a future **Mediterranean University**,
- enhanced cooperation on **marine and blue economy activities**,
